Phonics and Spelling	In phonics and spelling we will be learning to: -					
	Consolidate Year 2 sounds and spellings					
	Spell common high frequency words					
Reading	During our reading sessions we will be reading, Starbird					
	We will be introducing different types of comprehension questions (which we call VIPERS)					
	and practising these. The key skills we will be practicing include: -					
	Exploring new vocabulary and understanding new definitions. Developing approach to a secretary through information.					
	Developing empathy towards characters through inference.					
Writing	In writing this term, we will be creating character descriptions, setting descriptions and composing a minifact-file all based on the enchanting story of Starbird by Sharon King-Chai.					
Maths	In maths, we will be looking at: -					
	 number and place value; working with numbers up to and including thousands. 					
	identifying amounts,

	 comparing, estimating and ordering numbers. 					
	Children can login in at home to practice their maths using Mathletics and TT Rockstars;					
	Mathletics is certainly beneficial to children as we will be setting specific activities linked to					
	in school learning.					
Science	In science , additional to developing key scientific investigation skills, we will be developing					
	our scientific knowledge in our topic 'Animals including humans' and 'Plants'. We will					
	focusing on: -					
	Using different scientific enquiries to investigate these topics.					
History	In history lessons this term, children will be learning about Life during the Stone Age to the					
	Iron Age periods. They will compare the change over time and how people survived.					
Geography	In geography lessons this term, children will be learning about the United Kingdom and					
	comparing and contrasting the countries of the UK. We also look at human and physical					
	features. We will use maps to support our locational knowledge.					
RE	We will begin to learning about the Hindu religion and how they worship.					
PE	Our PE sessions this term will focus on invasion games and rounders skills.					
Computing	In computing we will be introduced to Apples pages and programming.					
PSHE	The topics we will begin with is 'Being me in my world' and moving on to 'Celebrating					
	Differences'.					
Art & Design	We will enjoy completing an enquiry using painting and drawing techniques.					
Design & Technology	After researching and designing our own pizza, we will each create a final product. Followed					
	by tasting and evaluating.					
Music	The children will begin to learn to play a 'Boomwhacker' in order to start to follow musica					
	notes on a stave.					
MFL	A simple introduction to French using greetings and information about myself.
