We hope that you and your family are well and enjoyed the summer break. As a year group team, we would like to take this opportunity to share with you an overview of the term ahead, with the aim to: -

- inform you of the **next steps** of your child's education;
- support your at-home discussions with your child(ren); and
- provide you with the tools to encourage additional practise at home.

Ribbon Virtues

Firstly, here is a reminder of Ribbon's key virtues. The 'RESPECT. framework supports our 'whole school approach' to be able to help children to develop these behaviour traits within everything we do at Ribbon. Our children will be praised and rewarded on the occasions that they showcase these virtues, so it is important they understand each virtue and when these are present in their behaviours.



Curriculum Overview

Subject	In-Class Coverage		
Phonics and Spelling	 In phonics and spelling we will be learning to: - Consolidate high frequency words Revise and learn spellings from the Year 3 and 4 spelling list 		
Reading	During our reading sessions we will be reading:		
	 Give/explain the meaning of words. Retrieve and record information from fiction and non-fiction. Summarise main ideas. Make inferences from the text. Predict what might happen. 		



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Subject	In-Class Coverage			
Writing	In writing this term, we will be studying and writing: Newspaper Reports Non-Chronological Reports; and Character Description 			
Maths	 In maths, we will be looking at: - Number and place value; working with numbers up to and beyond 1000. Recognising the place value of each digit in four-digit numbers. Identifying, representing and estimating amounts using different representations. Comparing, rounding and ordering numbers. 			
	Children can login in at home to practise their maths using Mathletics and TT Rockstars; Mathletics is certainly beneficial to children as we will be setting specific activities linked to in school learning.			
Science	 In Science, additional to developing key scientific investigation skills, we will be developing our scientific knowledge in our topic 'Living things and their habitats'. We will be focusing on: The main animal and plant groups and describing their features. Identifying the different animals and plant; and Identifying ways in which the environment changes. 			
History	 In history lessons this term, children will be learning about:- The Ancient Greek civilization. The Golden Age of Ancient Greece. The Olympic Games; and How the achievements of Ancient Greece have helped to influence the western world 			
Geography	 world. In geography lessons this term, children will be learning about:- Europe and naming their human and physical feature, and. Exploring map skills, enhanced with a local trip to Seaham. 			
RE	In RE lessons this term, children will be learning about the Bible and why it is important to Christians.			
PE	Our PE sessions this term will focus on skills within rounders.			
Computing	In computing we will be introduced to Apples pages and programming.			
PSHE	In PSHE lessons this term, our topics are 'Being me in my world' and 'Celebrating Differences'.			
Art & Design	In art lessons this term, we will be studying the artists Andreas Lie and Daniel Mackie, as well as developing our drawing and painting skills.			
Design & Technology	In DT lessons this term, we will be exploring a healthy and varied diet as well as creating our own healthy biscuits.			
Music	In music lessons this term, we will be strengthening our knowledge of recorders, as well as beginning whole-class clarinet sessions.			
MFL	In MFL lessons this term, we will focus on listening attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in.
