The Core

Reading/ Spelling
<p>Spelling</p> <p>In spelling, your child will continue to develop their knowledge of spelling rules and patterns to become more independent in spelling words with multiple syllables.</p> <p>Reading</p> <p>For the first four weeks of half term, we will be revising the key reading skills in preparation for SATs. As well as daily Book Club and Reading Plus sessions, your child will study the novel 'The Nowhere Emporium'. They will take part in discussions about the text and will develop their comprehension skills, focusing on understanding the vocabulary used by the author in the text.</p>
Writing
<p>Narrative</p> <p>Children will use a video stimulus to apply their writing skills to a story.</p> <p>SPAG</p> <p>Children will revise key SPAG skills in preparation for SATs.</p>
Maths
<p>SATs revision</p> <p>Children will be revising key concepts in preparation for SATs test.</p>
Science
<p>Science will be taught in Summer 2.</p>

<p>Art & Design will be taught in Summer 2.</p>
Design & Technology
<p>Design & Technology will be taught in Summer 2.</p>
Music
<p>Glockenspiels</p> <p>The children will be exposed to musical pieces of varying speeds and will decide on how quietly or loudly it should be played. They will also develop their understanding of the correct vocabulary to describe music.</p> <p>Music of the Moment</p> <p>Each day, they will listen to the 'Music of the Moment', which changes on a weekly basis. They will have the opportunity to discuss the music.</p>

<p>So, what do we know about Christianity?</p> <p>Your child will draw upon all previous learning to recall how Christians express their beliefs and how beliefs have an impact on how Christians live their lives.</p>
History
<p>History will be taught in Summer 2.</p>

The Wider Curriculum

PE
<p>Cricket</p> <p>This term, children will develop their bowling and fielding techniques, as well as tactics during a game to develop fieldwork.</p>
Computing
<p>Project Work</p> <p>This is the final project lesson within Computing. The children have learnt a lot of skills during their time at Ribbon Academy and have a strong understanding of a wide range of programmes. The idea of the 'project' is that a topic will be picked by the class teacher and the children will use all of their skills to create a PowerPoint to showcase all of their skills.</p>

<p>Describing People</p> <p>Children will learn how to describe appearances and characteristics in French. They will combine this with prior knowledge to engage in conversations.</p>
PSHE
<p>Relationships</p> <p>In this topic, your child will continue to study how to take care of their mental health. They will also look at healthy and unhealthy relationships and develop further strategies for solving problems and arguments with their peers.</p> <p>As well as this, children will apply their learning to the online world, to ensure that they continue to keep themselves safe in the real and virtual world.</p>
