What Parents Need to Know

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

In June 2025, all children in Y1 will complete their Statutory Phonics Screening Check. This is where each child must read 40 words including a range of sounds and spellings, where some words are real and some words are not.

More information will be shared with parents/carers later in the academic year. The dates are included below. Children **must** be in school during the Phonics Screening Week (Monday 2nd June to Friday 6th June)).

Home Reader

Children will receive a reading book from our school Reading Zone, alongside a yellow reading journal. These books must come to school each day for Book Club.

We would like to encourage each child to read at home for 10 minutes at least 3 times per week. Please sign the child's reading record to make a note of their reading.

<u>Homework</u>

In Y1, children receive homework every Monday. This must be completed and returned by the Friday. A copy will be uploaded to Class Dojo.

Labelling Uniform

Please ensure all uniforms are clearly labelled with your child's name. This will support us to return any lost items. The lost property is located at Main Reception, in between the automatic doors, to the left.

<u>PE Kits</u>

PE lessons in Y1 are scheduled for every **Monday and Tuesday**. However, timetables may change so any changes will be communicated via Class Dojo, as soon as possible.

PE kit in Year 1 includes the following items:

- Plain white t-shirt
- Green shorts / black joggers / black leggings
- Long hair to be tied back
- Black hoody or jumper
- Trainers

Year 1 children can come into school wearing their Ribbon PE kit on PE days.

Water Bottles

We ask each child to come to school with a water bottle to ensure they are fully hydrated throughout the school day. We advise only water or juice. Water bottles can be refilled at any point throughout the school day.
