What Parents Need to Know

Multiplication Check

In June 2025, all children in Y4 will complete their Statutory Multiplication Check. This is where each child must answer 25 multiplication style questions in a time-limit of 6 seconds per question.

The timetables asked will range from X1 to X12, and anything in between (this will also include X0).

More information will be shared with parents/carers later in the academic year. The dates are included below. Children **must** be in school during the Multiplication Check Fortnight window (Monday 2nd June to Friday 13th June).

Home Reader

Children will receive a reading book from our school Reading Zone, alongside a yellow reading journal. These books must come to school each day for Book Club.

We would like to encourage each child to read at home for 10 minutes at least 3 times per week. Please sign the child's reading record to make a note of their reading.

Homework

In Y4, children receive homework every Monday. This must be completed and returned by the Friday. A copy will be uploaded to Class Dojo.

Labelling Uniform

Please ensure all uniforms are clearly labelled with your child's name. This will support us to return any lost items. The lost property is located at Main Reception, in between the automatic doors, to the left.

PE Kits

PE lessons in Y4 are scheduled for every **Tuesday and Thursday**. However, timetables can change and so we ask that children bring their PE kit every Monday and this will be returned each Friday. PE kit in Year 4 includes the following items:

- Plain white t-shirt
- Green shorts / black joggers / black leggings
- Long hair to be tied back
- Black hoodie or jumper
- Trainers

Water Bottles

We ask each child to come to school with a water bottle to ensure they are fully hydrated throughout the school day. We advise only water or juice. Water bottles can be refilled at any point throughout the school day. **Please note that we are a nut free school.**
