Spelling

In spelling, your child will continue to develop their knowledge of spelling rules and patterns to become more independent in spelling words with multiple syllables.

<u>Reading</u>

They will take part in discussions about the text and will develop their comprehension skills, focusing on understanding the vocabulary used by the author in the text.
