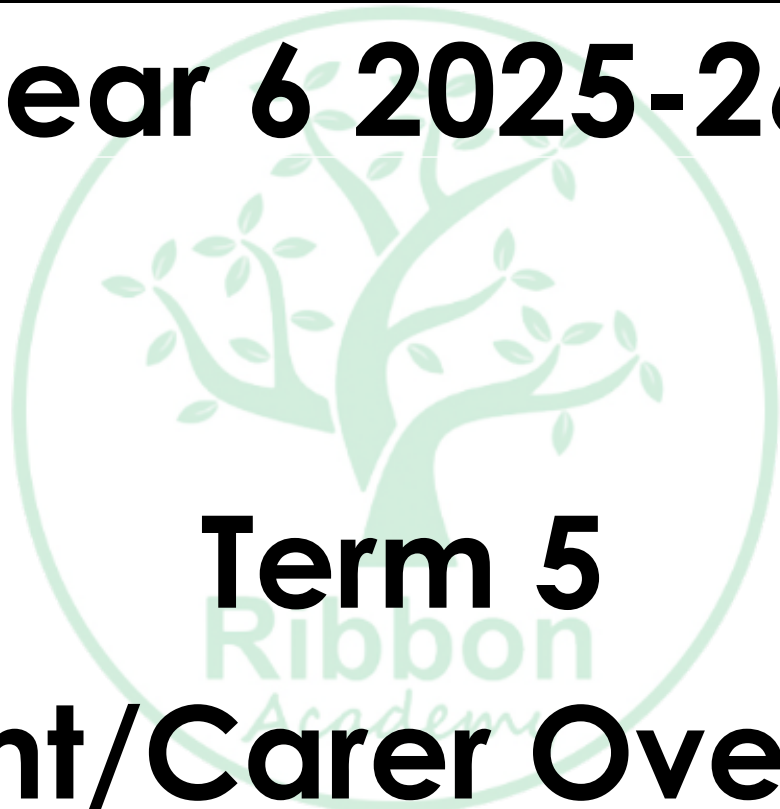

# Parent/Carer Overview

### The Core

Reading/ Spelling
<p><b>Spelling</b></p> <p>In spelling, your child will continue to develop their knowledge of spelling rules and patterns to become more independent in spelling words with multiple syllables.</p> <p><b>Reading</b></p> <p>For the first two weeks of half term, we will be revising the key reading skills in preparation for SATs. As well as daily Book Club and Reading Plus sessions, your child will study the novel 'The Final Year'. They will take part in discussions about the text and will develop their comprehension skills, focusing on understanding the vocabulary used by the author in the text.</p>
Writing
<p><b>Narrative</b></p> <p>Your child will use a video stimulus from Literacy Shed to apply their writing skills to a story, considering vocabulary, sentence structure and punctuation for effect.</p> <p><b>SPAG</b></p> <p>Your children will continue their revision of key SPAG skills in preparation for the upcoming End of Key Stage 2 SATs.</p>
Maths
<p><b>SATs revision</b></p> <p>Your child will be revising key concepts covered in Key Stage 2 in preparation for the upcoming SATs test. This will include the application of concepts within problem solving and reasoning questions.</p>
Science
<p><b>Science will be taught in Term 6.</b></p>

Art & Design
<p><b>Art &amp; Design will be taught in Term 6.</b></p>
Design & Technology
<p><b>Design &amp; Technology will be taught in Term 6.</b></p>
Music
<p><b>Glockenspiels</b></p> <p>Your child will be exposed to musical pieces of varying speeds and will decide on how quietly or loudly it should be played. They will also develop their understanding of the correct vocabulary to describe music.</p> <p><b>Music of the Moment</b></p> <p>Each day, they will listen to the 'Music of the Moment', which changes on a weekly basis. They will have the opportunity to discuss the music.</p>

### The Humanities

Geography
<p><b>Geography will be taught in Term 6.</b></p>

<p><b>So, what do we know about Christianity?</b></p> <p>Your child will draw upon all previous learning to recall how Christians express their beliefs and how beliefs have an impact on how Christians live their lives.</p>
History
<p><b>History will be taught in Term 6.</b></p>

### The Wider Curriculum

PE
<p><b>Basketball</b></p> <p>Your child will develop their ball handling and passing skills, focusing on chest and bounce pass. They will also develop their ability to dribble, pass and shoot whilst running and moving into space. Additionally, they will learn the correct shooting technique, focusing on hitting targets to score points. Children will put their learned skills into invasion-based games.</p>
Computing
<p><b>Project Work</b></p> <p>This is the final project lesson within Computing. Your child has learnt a lot of skills during their time at Ribbon Academy and have a strong understanding of a wide range of programmes. The idea of the 'project' is that a topic will be picked by the class teacher and they will use all of their skills to create a PowerPoint to showcase all of their skills.</p>
MFL
<p><b>As-tu un animal ? (Do You Have a Pet?)</b></p> <p>Your child will learn the names of various types of pets. They will create longer phrases using the conjunctions et (and) or mais (but). They will take part in conversations and written work around this topic.</p>
PSHE
<p><b>Relationships</b></p> <p>In this topic, your child will continue to study how to take care of their mental health.
